We respond to, and build on children's individual strengths. We acknowledge that the family are the most powerful influence in their child's life and encourage families to share their culture, building on each child's sense of identity.

We value the importance of children learning through play. Play is at the heart of every child. We encourage and support their love for learning, providing them with time and a balance of child led, meaningful conversations, and child initiated quality learning. Educators provide opportunities for risk taking, through regular excursions, playgroups, and outings in the community.
